

christmas tree ornaments



I Cup Flour, ½ cup table salt, ½ cup warm water, acrylic paint or ink pad, cookie cutter, black sharpie, and mod podge, rolling pin, and ribbon

In a bowl mix flour, salt, and warm water. Knead the dough with your hand until combined (add more water if too dry, more flour if too sticky a tsp at a time). Use a rolling pin to roll out flat. Use a tree cutter to cut dough and star cutter for the star. Have kids press fingertips onto the tree. Use a straw or pencil to make a hole at the top. Bake at 350* for 3 hours and flip halfway through. Once cooled have child press fingers into ink pad and then into the indents made on the tree. Connect indents with sharpie for the lights and write the year at the bottom. Seal with mod podge. Tie a ribbon at the top to be hung on the tree.

STRAWBERRY SANTAS
